Summary: Meeting served as an introduction to the KPMG Consulting team for Mr. McNair, and as a means for determining what would make this a successful project from Mr. McNair's perspective. Mr. McNair placed a strong emphasis on process improvement, as opposed to technology improvement.

Mr. McNair: We need to reach into that connection with IWARs [info system] somehow. This is a hazy area. (CDR McAtee agrees).

Mr. Pfoztzer: By the time IWARs provides info to MC PR, PR is pretty much already underway.

Mr. Sones: N-81 went through BPR process recently ("BEI"). How do we re-integrate them with the PPBS process. Example: timing is a bit off now.

???: We should include N-81 input to the process.

Mr. McNair: Make sure As-Is shows reality, not "should be."

Mr. McNair: It is important to have visibility of organizations that perform activities, and possible redundancies across organizations. A perspective on destination of dollars is also important.

Mr. McNair: We need to make sure we define the scope of this BPR effort. The '85 document is still 85% accurate, and is a good starting point.

Mr. McNair: We can't forget execution, because it is feedback as well as input back.
