Summary: Meeting served as an introduction to the KPMG Consulting team for Mr. Mohler, and as a means for determining what would make this a successful project from Mr. Mohler's perspective. Mr. Mohler sees technology as the tool that will improve FYDP.

Mr. Mohler: We need to find out where KM in Navy and USMC is going. OSD not quite as far ahead as us - they have very rigid structure. The best quality assurance method is peer review. My vision is that we have a single database, accessible to everyone throughout the Navy that has a need to know. The database should ride the backbone of the Navy and USMC internet structure. Scope of data elements and who owns them is a bit fuzzy at this time. Force tables and count of FYDP come from other databases, but are they [databases] in scope of this effort?
